ADVOCACY UPDATE

Parking Enforcement Reform

Several members of the **Downtown Alliance** attended the 5/13 city council meeting to endorse Councilman Deno Hondros' initiative to reduce paid parking on weekdays from 7pm to 5pm. Thank you to everyone whot was able to participate on short notice. If you were unable to attend, please contact any council members you know and express your desire to have the hours reduced.

Proposed MSD Tax Increase

Also at the May 13th city council meeting, the initial 24-25 budget was presented by the city manager that included a *significant* MSD Tax increase. This proposed increase is a surprise and has happened without any property owner or member input. The **Downtown Alliance** will continue to learn, report and advocate on this issue.

Event Impact on Local Business Economy

Multiple businesses reported being negatively impacted by this year's Dogwood Festival. In response, members of the **Downtown Alliance** Executive Committee and the Cool Spring Downtown District (CSDD) staff met to discuss concerns and began compiling a best practices document for downtown event producers.


